- 1. Apologies for absence accepted. 17 people attended AGM. 2010 minutes agreed.
- 2. Risk assessment has been updated. Hand gel has been added to the first aid box.
- 3. The secretary's report was read out.
- 4. Dates have been submitted to Bromley Council for next year with 2 night meetings making 12 dates in total.
- 5. There is currently no treasurer's report to hand out due to sickness. The club is still in the black. The club has bought a banner and flagpole, paid for the pond hire, insurance and hall for the AGM.

Petts Wood 2012 May Fayre will be on 7th May and we are looking for volunteers to help on the stand. Other events were talked about but there were no volunteers to help organize any of the events.
- 11. The committee was re-elected for 2012, Les Fastier, Margaret Hoare and Paul Allen.
- 12. It was discussed that club members could bring "windbreaks" to help cordon off the public. The lights worked well round the pond on the night regattas.
